



Standards for PSIA-AASI Member Schools

There are two classes of PSIA-AASI snowsports member schools:

- 1. Certified Member Schools**
- 2. Registered Member Schools.**

The standards for each class have been ratified by the ASEA Board of Directors.

Certified Member School Standards

1. The school teaches skiing and/or snowboarding as a primary business and operates under an IRS Employer Identification Number (EIN).
2. The school provides verification of an approved venue of operation.
3. The school accepts and incorporates into its training and programs the fundamental teaching philosophies contained in educational materials developed and distributed by PSIA-AASI.
4. The school is required to provide in-service training for all instructor staff.
5. The director or other person designated to be in charge of training is required to attend a national or divisional educational event on an annual basis.
6. The person in charge of training instructors for the school — on-staff or contracted — shall hold PSIA Level III or AASI Level III certification in good standing.

Registered Member School Standards

1. The school teaches skiing and/or snowboarding as a primary business and operates under and IRS Employer Identification Number (EIN).
2. The school provides verification of an approved venue of operation.
3. The school accepts and incorporates into its training and programs the fundamental teaching philosophies contained in educational materials developed and distributed by PSIA-AASI.
4. The school is required to provide in-service training for all instructor staff.
5. The director or other person designated to be in charge of training is required to attend a national or divisional educational event on an annual basis.
