#### **Course Description:**

The Level 1 (4-day) certification preparation event was developed by PSIA-W education staff to train new instructors on the basic competencies for Level 1 Certification. Participants will learn how to plan, develop, and deliver lessons for skier's levels 1-4 along with demonstrating technical accuracy in skiing performance areas as outlined in the L1 Western Division Study Guide.

### Learning Experiences:

- Participants will practice how to use the Teaching/Learning Cycle including how to develop progressions for adults/children, and how to identify and address common problems.
- Participants will become familiar with the Learning Connection and develop a basic understanding of the fundamentals for Teaching, People, and Technical skills.
- Participants will use personal skiing development along with practicing common demonstrations for guests and technical competencies, to learn about the Skills Concept and Alpine Technical Fundamentals.
- Participants will review and learn how to use the model for conducting movement analysis as it applies to personal technical skills and skiers in the beginner zone.
